The lecture will be delivered byDr. Mohammad Iqbal Chaudhry, a Pakistani scientist and scholar in the field of organic chemistry.

Dr. Chaudhry is known for his research in various areas relating to natural product chemistry. He has more than 800 research publications including 32 books published, and 24 patents. He has been awarded the Tamgha-e-Imtiaz, Sitara-e-Imtiaz, and Hilal-e-Imtiaz. In 2015, he was recognized as the second most productive scientist in Pakistan.
